

MuCEM, Marseille

The MuCEM (Musée des Civilisations de l'Europe et de la Méditerranée) in Marseille

"This edifice of stone, water and wind" conceived by the architect Rudy Ricciotti, transforms at night into a magical green and blue milky way.

Yann Kersalé has illuminated the concrete lacework with a series of 2-colour blue/green spotlights 4240 - Havre.

At the top, special lights 5631 - Belval pick out a plunging walkway and 1530 - Bordeaux cover the terrace.

The moats are bathed by 5631 - Belval.

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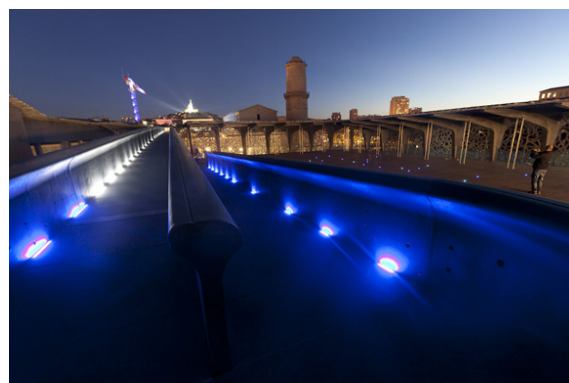
