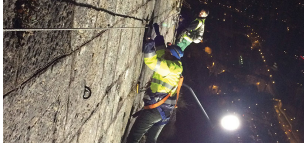

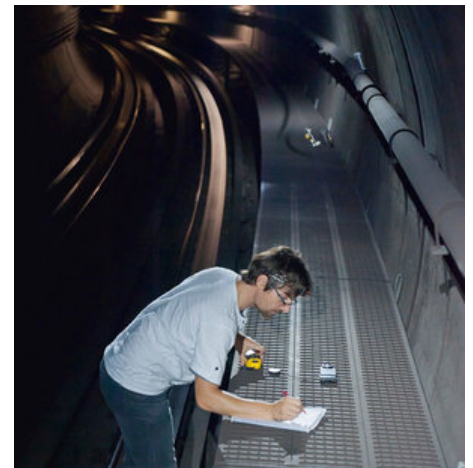
LEC: by your side, no matter the circumstances.
